AERIAL VIEW





Camp Verde is located 86 miles north of Phoenix in Yavapai County. As a result of being geographically centered in the state's lush Verde Valley, the climate is moderate. 
The populations is less than 11,000. The Town consists of fields of flat river-plain, traversed by the Verde River (18 miles of river lies within the Town limits) and its tributaries, with desert hills and mesas rising in the forefront of the distant mountains.
